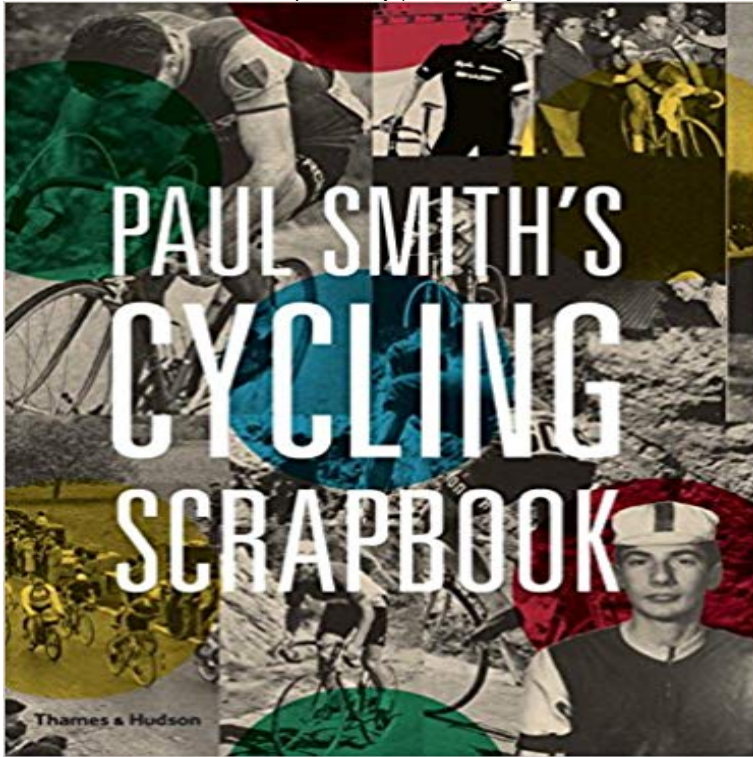


Paul Smiths Cycling Scrapbook
