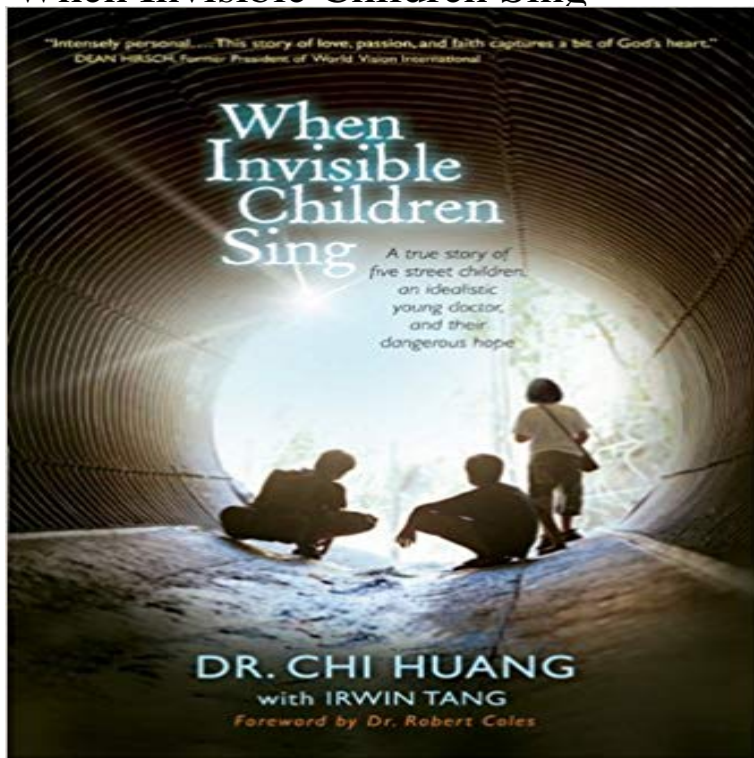


# When Invisible Children Sing
