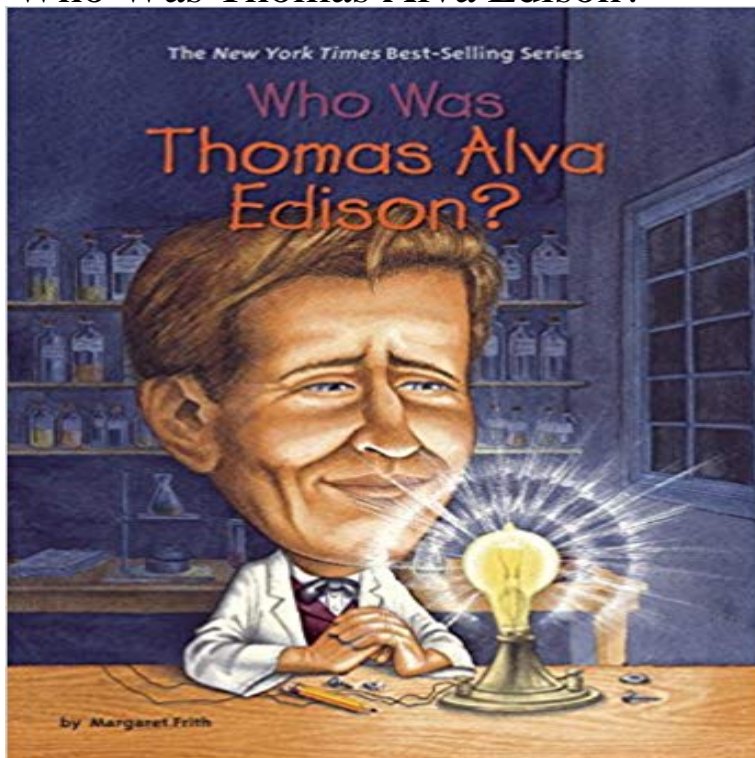


# Who Was Thomas Alva Edison?
